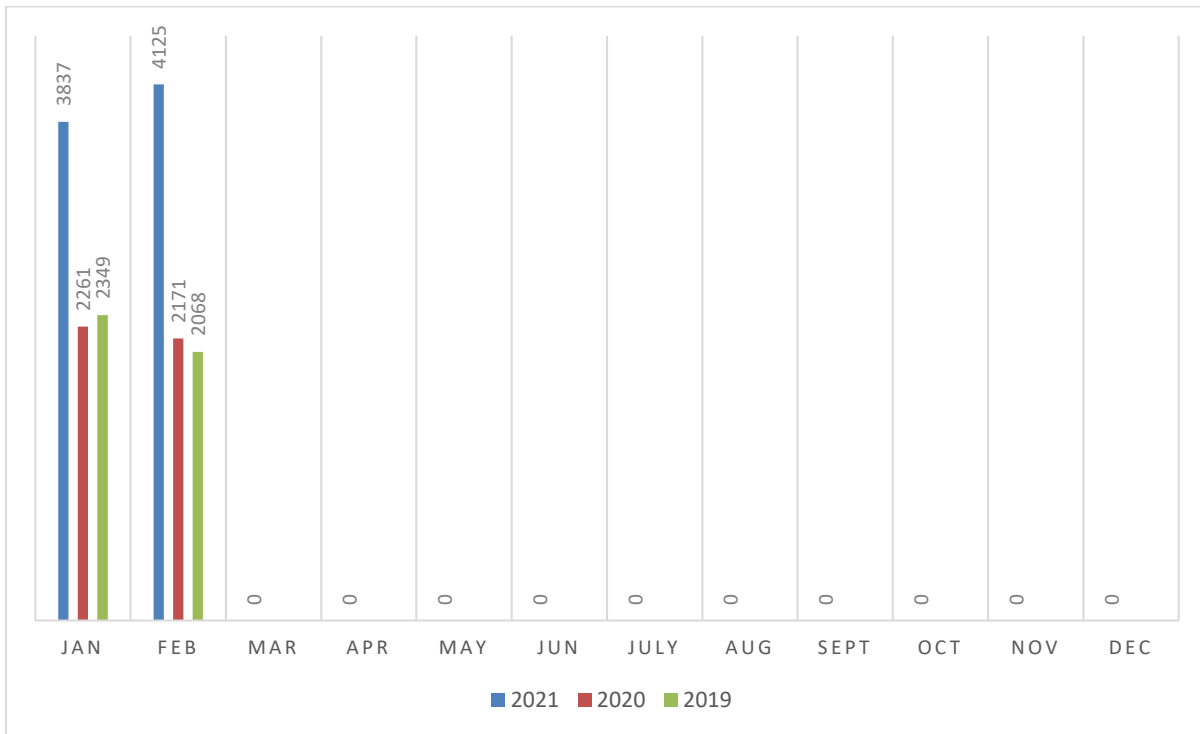
The following report includes information for 211 South as reported by Distress Centre Calgary.

Summary:

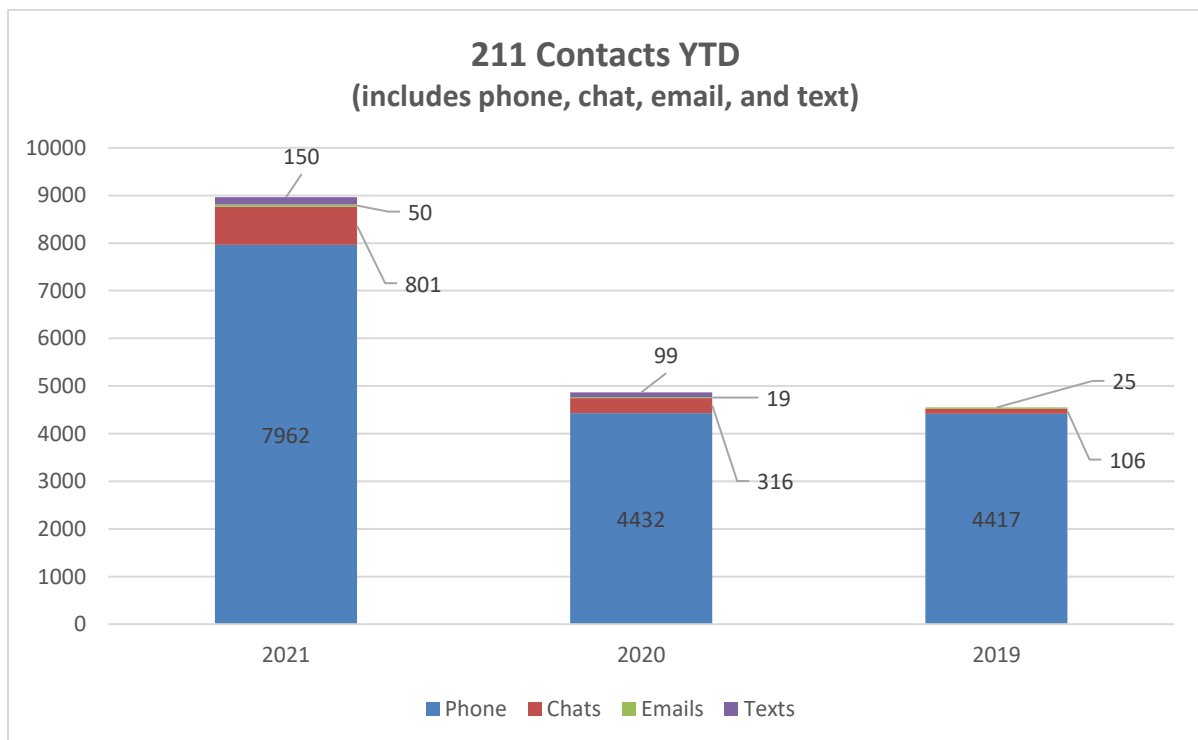
- February's call volume increased by 90% compared to February 2020 and increased by 99% compared to February 2019
- Overall contact volume (all modes of contact) for February increased by 95% and 118% when compared with February 2020 and February 2019 respectively.
- The 211 chat and text services are responded to in collaboration between the Distress Centre Calgary contact centre and the Canadian Mental Health Association- Edmonton Region contact centre.
 - Calgary is responsible answering chats from 12am-12pm. Calgary responded to 438 chats in February, which is almost 3 times the chat contacts in February 2020 (158).
 - The 211 text service was soft launched July 17, 2019 with limited hours and expanded to 24/7 in February 2020. We responded to 68 texts in February.



Monthly 211 Call Volume:



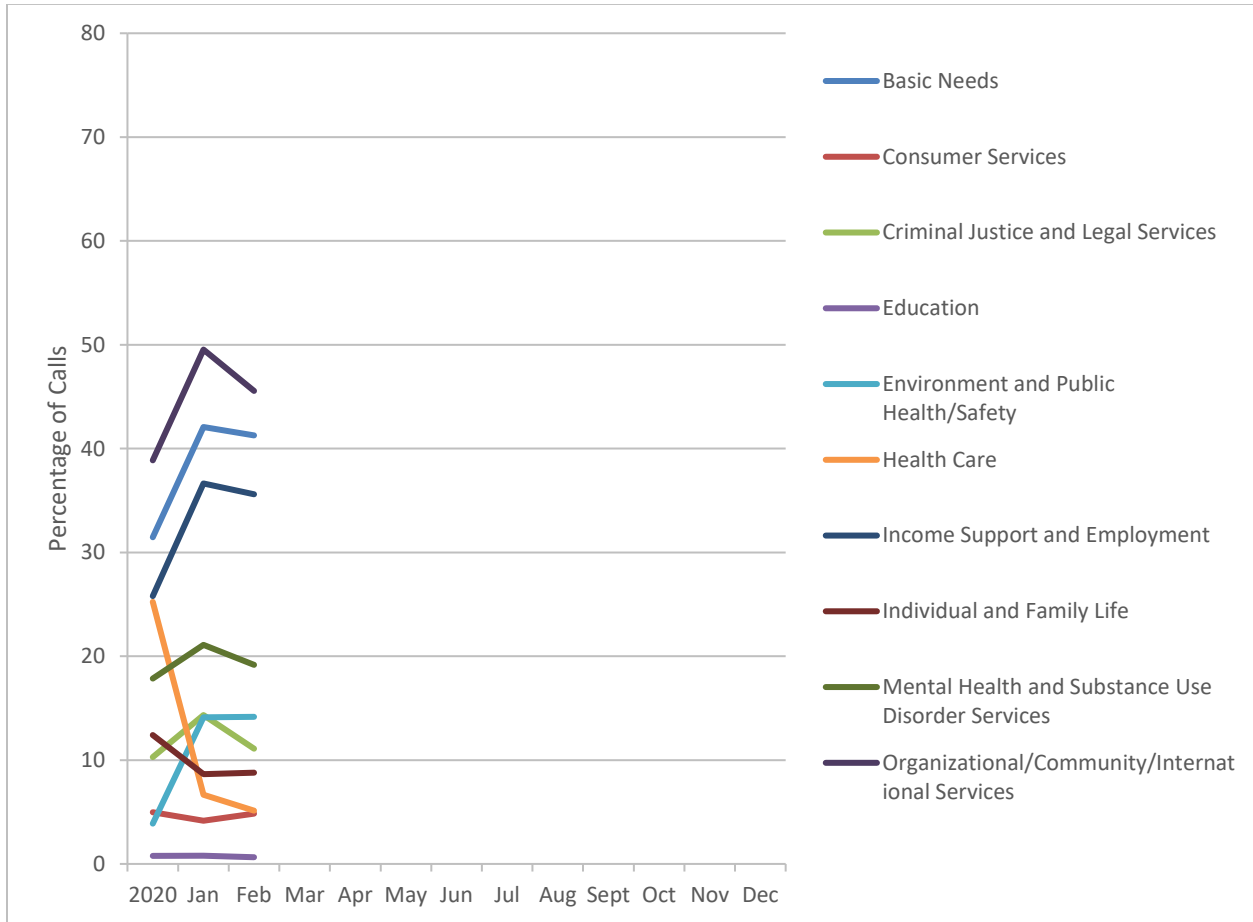
Year-To-Date 211 Contacts Volume:





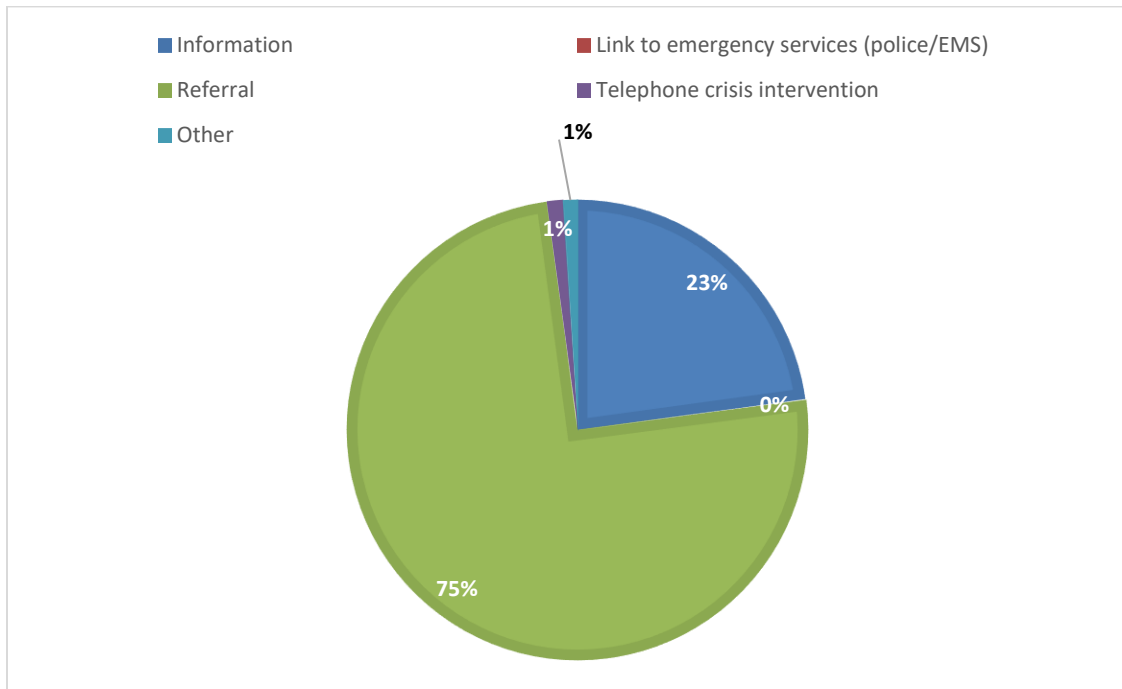

The issues users discussed can be grouped into ten categories.

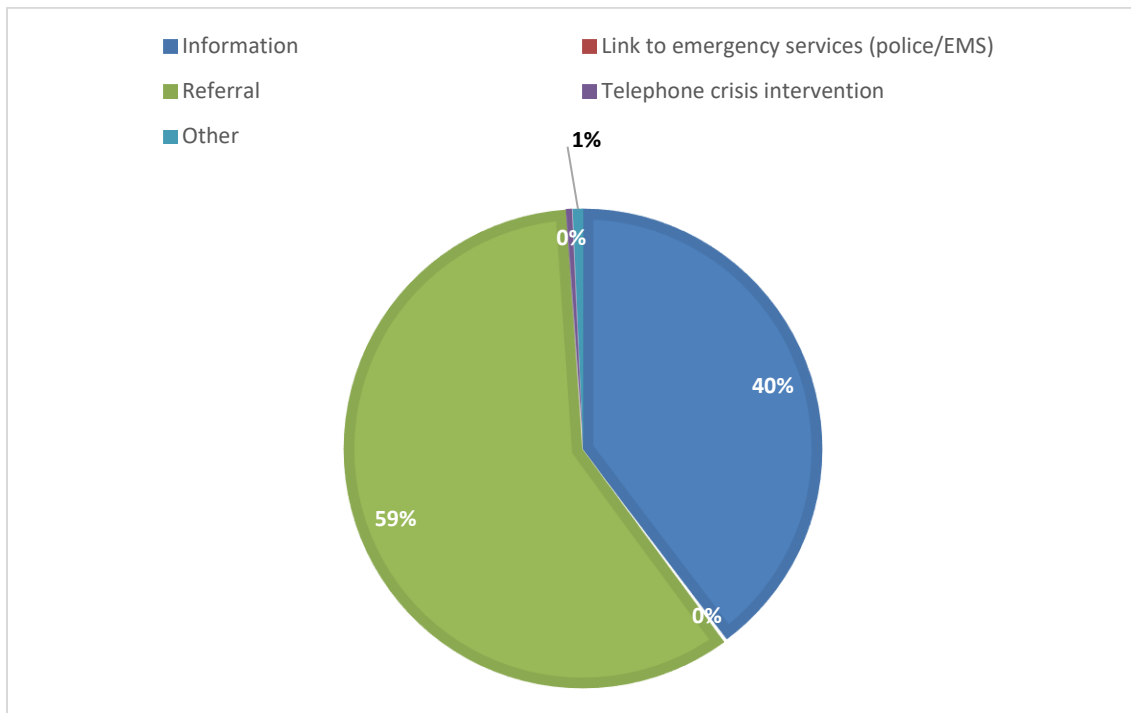




Service Provided YTD – Phone Contacts:

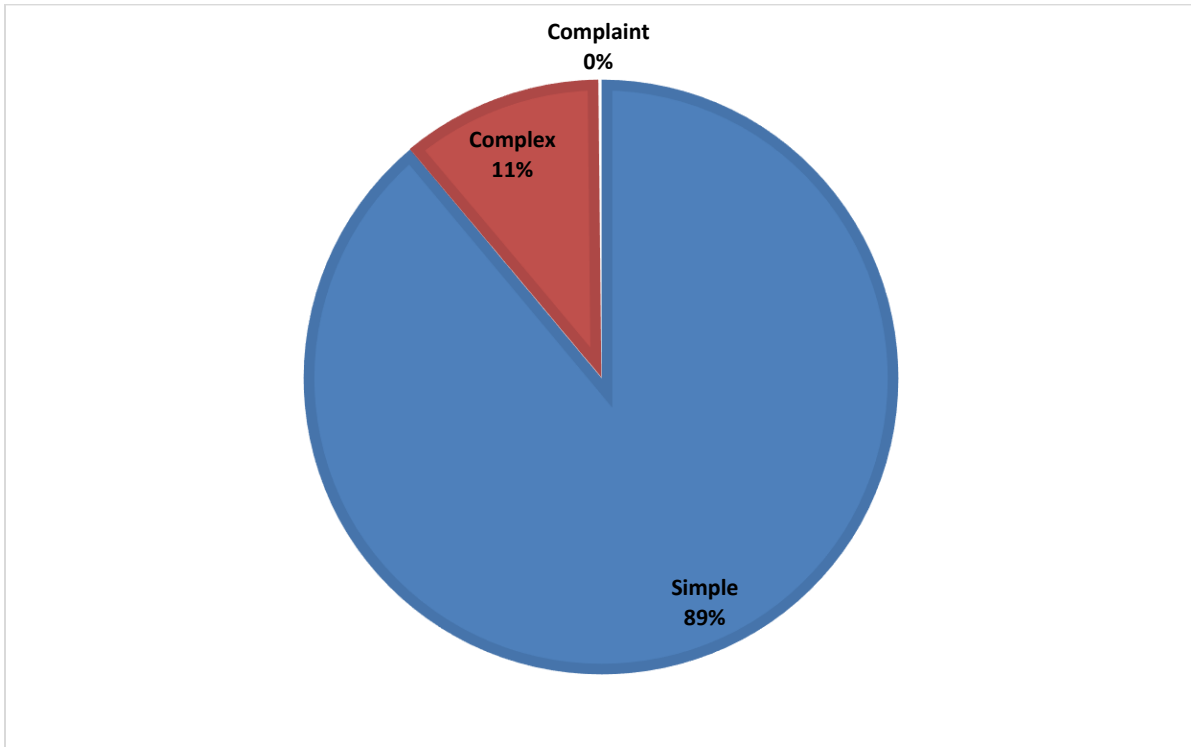


Service Provided YTD – Online Contacts:

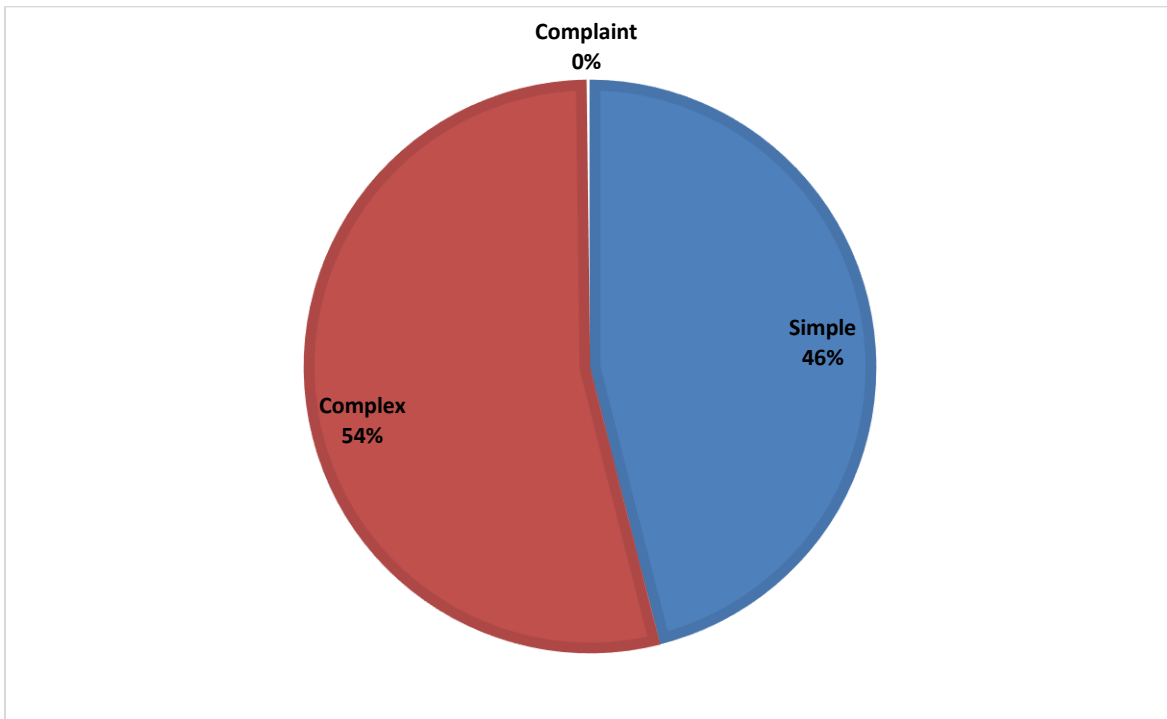




Call Type YTD – Phone Contacts:

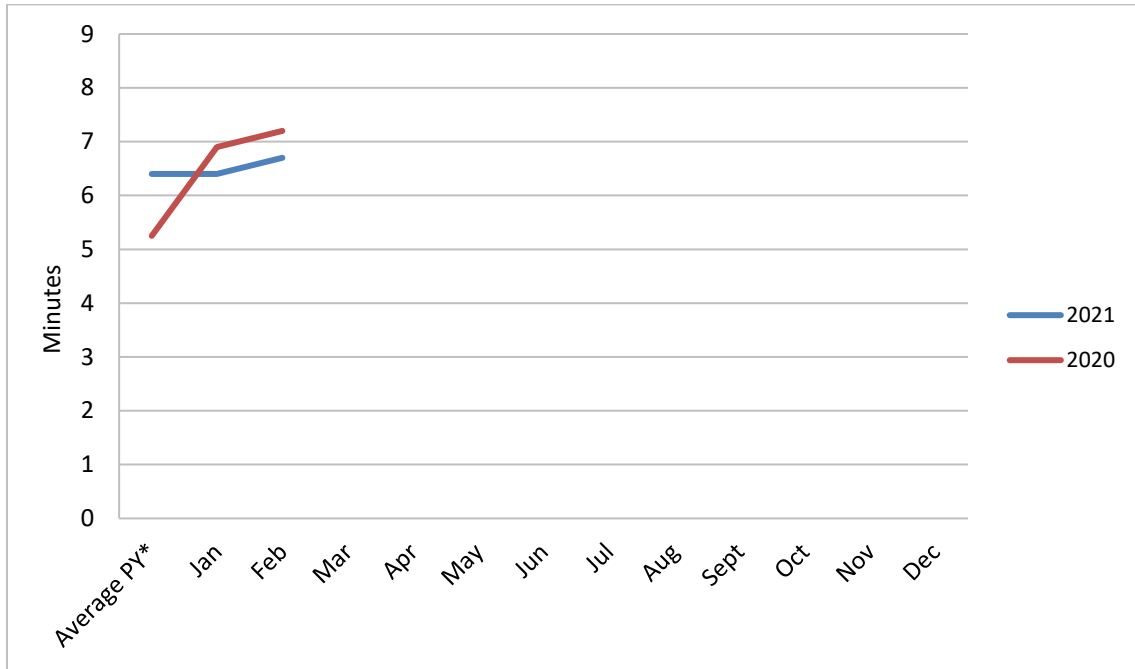

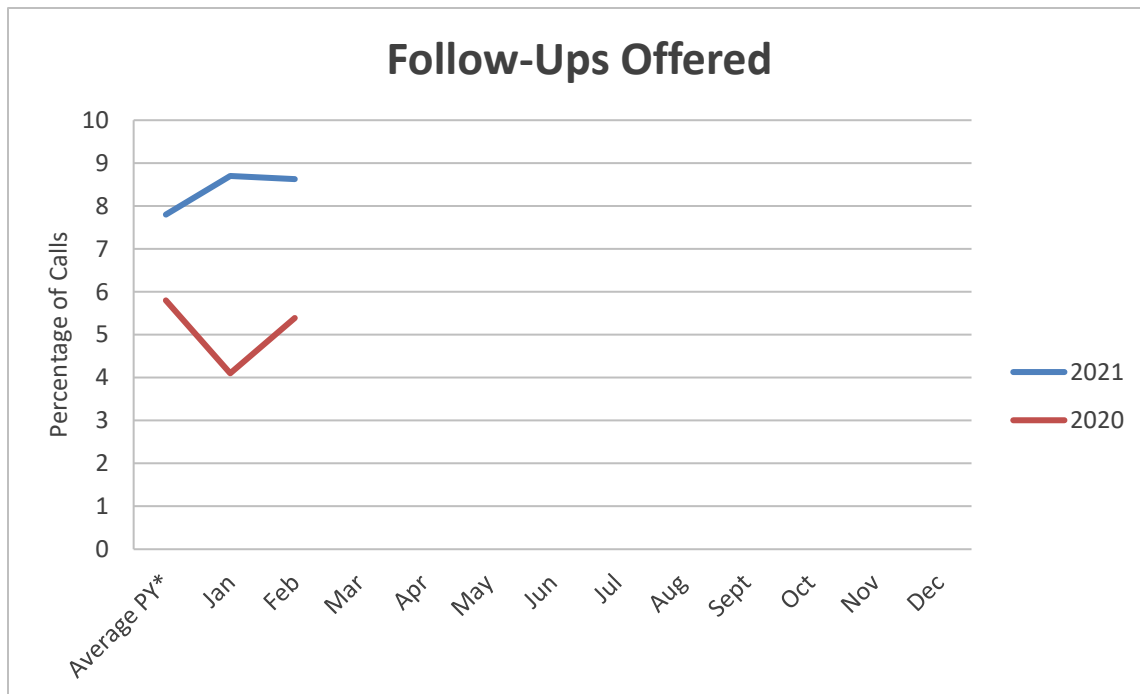


Average Length of Call:



*Average PY refers to average length of call for previous year.

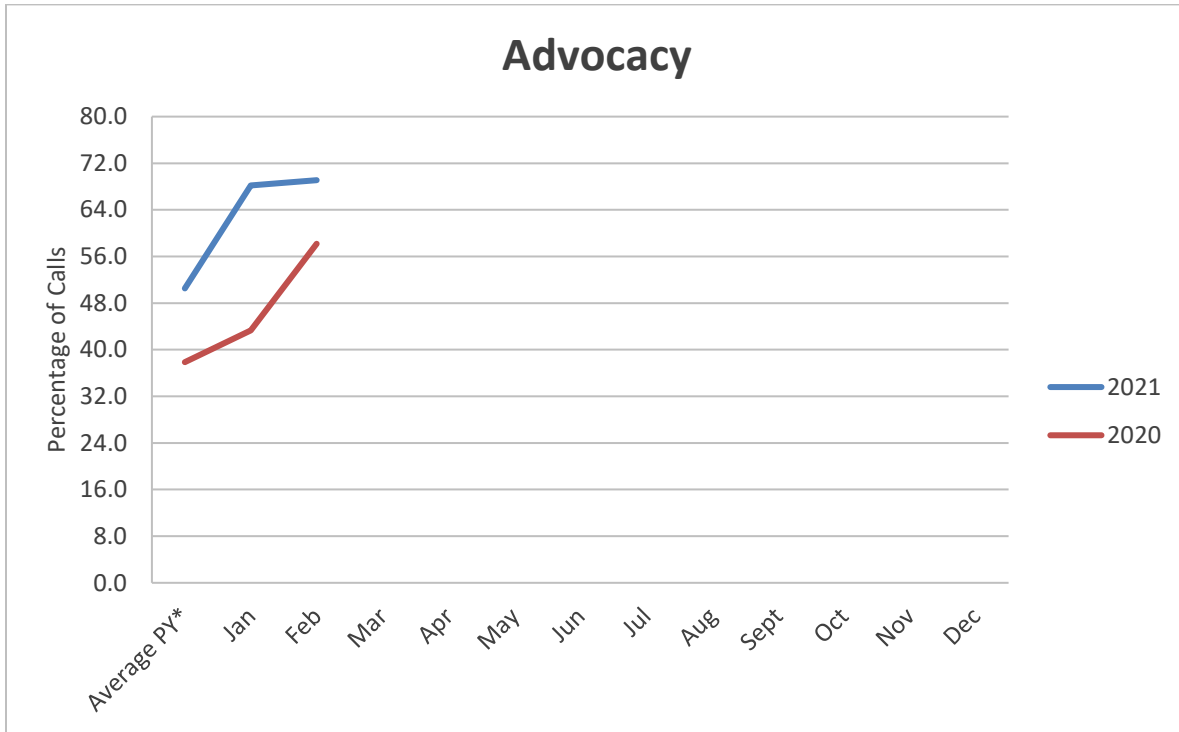
Follow-Ups Offered:

Advocacy:

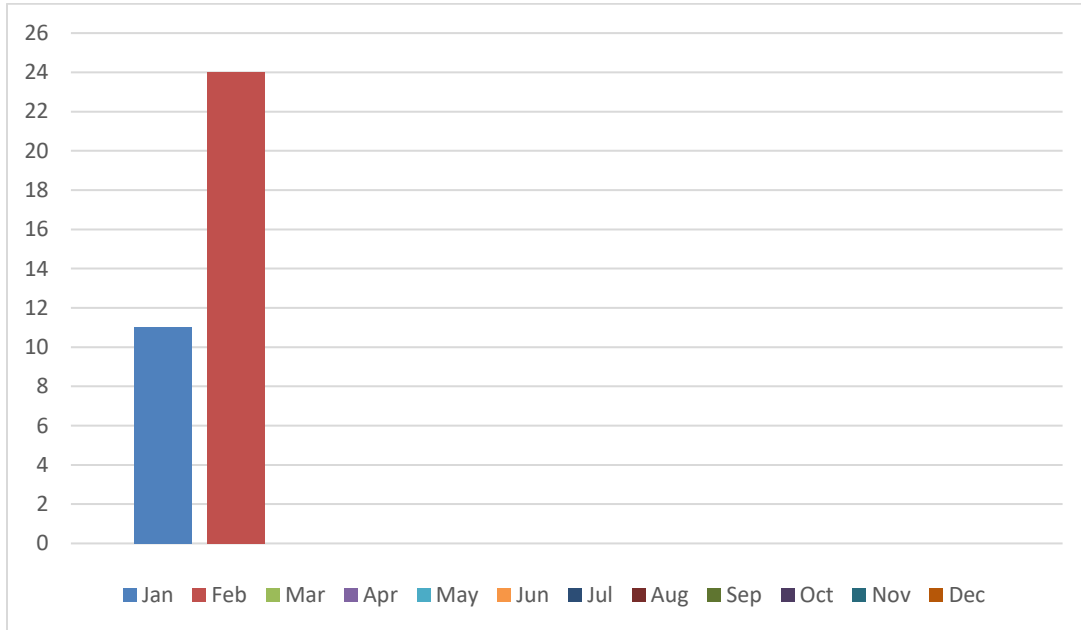


*Average PY refers average number of advocacies for previous year.
